



2019 REPEAL MOVEMENT

2019 kicks off with a bang addressing two key issues. The year's major provisions were:

- The Individual Mandate penalty for not having minimum essential coverage is zeroed out as part of the Tax Cut and Jobs Act of 2017.
- The Medicare Part D coverage gap known as the "donut hole" in the prescription drug benefit is phased out. Seniors will pay a standard 25% of drug costs until they reach the threshold for Medicare catastrophic coverage. This was a result of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 which accelerated the closure of this coverage gap from 2020 to 2019.
